- Carla Zanichelli-Vives - Clinical Lead Lymphoedema Service, University College London Hospital

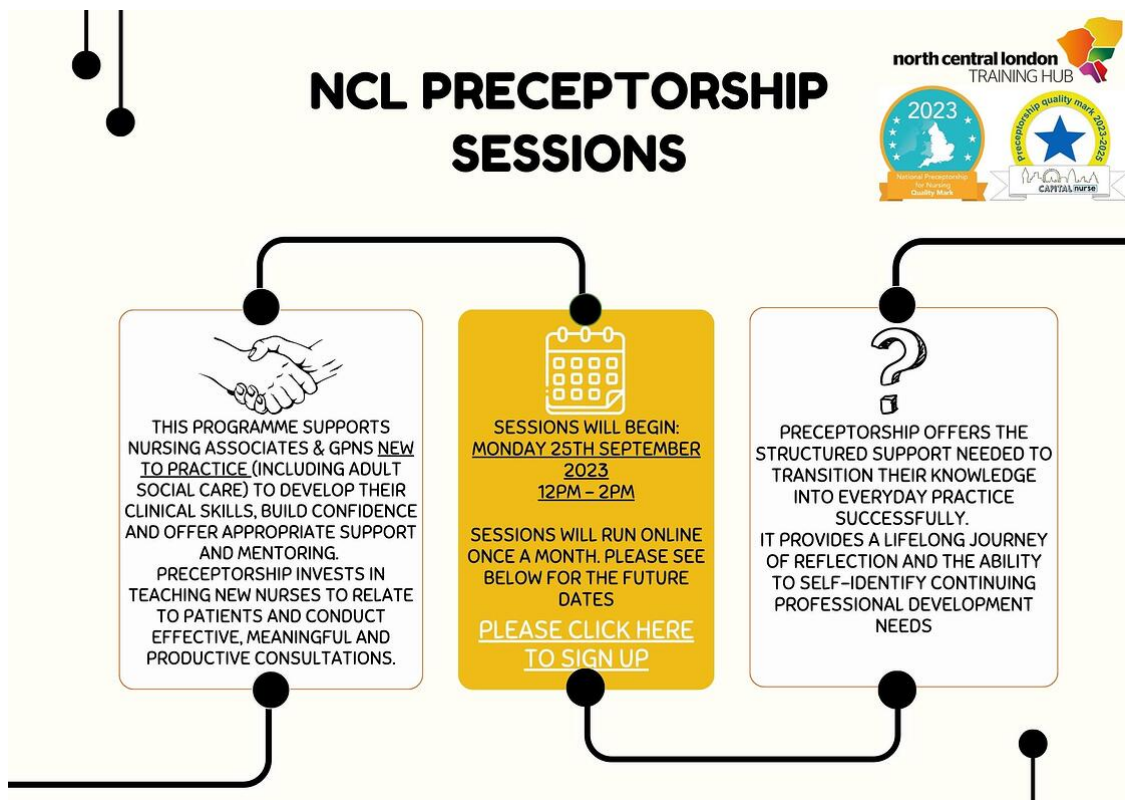
