Postgraduate Certificate Opportunities

Submit EOIs by Friday 30th June

Postgraduate Certificate in Healthcare Practice for GPNs

This course helps develop systems leadership and workforce transformation skills through delivery of quality improvement projects. The course consists of 3 modules (60 credits), delivered over 12 months at Canterbury Christ Church University. Learners must be able to commit one day per week to study days and taught sessions.

Postgraduate Certificate in Clinical Education for GPNs

The Post Graduate Certificate in Education is a year long course in a university and is all about learning how to teach, supervise, assess and evaluate within a Clinical setting. For example, you may want to become, or already are a Nurse Education Lead in your PCN. This course will give you an excellent foundation to develop your skills and knowledge and enable you to further your Educational Career. The funding is aimed at General Practice
